Using Lopo ensures a stress-free headspace, and a future without needing to look over your shoulder.

The Safe is a secret hidden app - a secure digital diary, that allows women who suffer from gaslighting and other forms of abuse, to document what is happening to them. By using The Safe, they can upload physical evidence that can be used for legal purposes, and can use it to fight the gaslighting being done to them. Many aggressors stalk their spouses digitally, and so The Safe sends all the files to a secure external cloud and deletes them automatically from the phone without leaving any digital traces. The only one who has access to the files is the woman who uploaded them.

Timeout is a tool for people who are already in treatment to address their violent behavior. Unlike other solutions that focus on the user himself, this innovation is oriented for therapists to adapt the treatment method in a modular way, according to the nature and progress of the patient. Timeout is based on a well-known technique for treating people with violent tendencies, the main patterns of which are: cutting off contact with the person you conflict with; lack of emotional and cognitive processing; and set the foundations for direct and positive communication with the person you are or were in conflict with.

Viosense is an app that integrates with popular dating platforms and warns users - in real-time - about potential matches that have been reported by other members of the Viosense community. With a community- driven reporting system, users have the power to report instances of harassment or violent behavior, creating a safer and more pleasant space for people to meet.

When Viosense observes a dangerous exchange, the app can assist in numerous ways - send notices, reach out to an emergency contact, or even let you anonymously consult with someone familiar with the person sending you questionable messages.




Ruthi
